If you have a fever, cough, and/or difficulty breathing, even if MILD, do not enter the pharmacy. Staff will be actively screening individuals over the phone and upon entering the pharmacy. Please refrain from socializing and waiting for your prescription in the pharmacy. Pay by credit or debit, whenever possible! We do accept credit card payment over the telephone. We <u>may</u> be limiting the number of customers within the store at a given time to ensure social distancing. Plan for what you need, and shop efficiently. Ask us for help.

3 ways to request your prescription refills:

Telephone 705-966-3612	Before you call, have a list READY of what you need refilled. Ideally, give us the <u>PRESCRIPTION NUMBER</u> , located on the top, left hand corner of your prescription label. If you don't have this number, have the name of the drug ready. Be very specific with your requests. Leave a phone number so we know how to reach you if we have any questions.
Email <u>levackpharmacy@gmail.com</u>	In the subject line, indicate "refill request", then in the email message, indicate the prescription number(s) or the name(s) of the medication. Be very specific with your requests. Leave your name and phone number.
diem® health for I.D.A. I.D.A. Pharmacy	Download the "diem health for I.D.A" app on your smart phone or tablet and send us your prescription requests. We will notify you when your prescription is ready.

Please be aware that our phone line will be very busy. Try to keep the phone line open for the elderly or for those who do not have access to the internet....if you have access to email or a smartphone/tablet, please use these methods for communicating with us. Our email will be checked continuously throughout the day.

ONCE YOUR ORDER IS COMPLETE, WE WILL NOTIFY YOU AND MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR SAFE PICK-UP --- please do not try to pick-up your prescriptions until you have been notified.

Refill requests for chronic-use medications: We kindly ask that you give us at least 7 days' notice for all refill requests. This includes, but is not limited to, medication for diabetes, high blood pressure, cholesterol, gout, stomach, thyroid, heart, etc. By sending us your requests 7 days in advance, we will have enough time to contact your prescriber if you need a new prescription or if other problems arise.

Once your order is complete, we will contact you and arrange for safe pick-up.

NEW PRESCRIPTIONS: ask your prescriber to call-in or fax over your new prescription. Ensure your phone number is included so we can call you to let you know when your prescription is ready for pick up.

Let's all work together to stop the spread of this virus and strengthen the bonds that keep our community healthy and safe! Thank-you.





loe & Childa MacDonald by Jana Niemi-Lahnalampi

If you don't recognize these names you will certainly recognize the faces. Childa and Joe MacDonald have been active at St. Bartholomew's Church and the wider community for over forty-five years! They raised their family in Levack: Kevin, Keith and Bobbie Jo.

Both Childa and Joe are Maritimers, Childa was born in New Brunswick while Joe was raised on Cape Breton. Joe moved to the area in 1965 as a summer student at Falconbridge's Hardy Mill and never left. Childa worked in Sudbury as Bell Telephone operator when they were set up on a blind date. This past summer they celebrated their 50th anniversary, surrounded by family and friends. Their deep commitment to each other and their family grew to encompass their faith community and our small town. For 35 years Childa has been an active member of her church: as choir director, member of the Diocesan order of Women, CWL, and leader sacramental preparation classes.

In the past, she led church youth groups and helped with community lunches and dinners. Joe too is an active member of St. Bartholomew's: he served in many positions from Parish Council to building maintenance, he is an ordained Deacon and a Knights of Columbus Charter member; holding executive roles in the Knights of Columbus for over 25 years, including Grand Knight. When his family was younger, Joe supported their interests by being actively involved in minor hockey and softball, holding executive positions in both organizations. At one point he was president of both the Minor Softball Association and the Trailer Park Association. Joe was also an executive for over 20 years of Mine Mill Union Local 598, he never lost an election. Both were inspired by Father MacLellan to volunteer.

Joe's fondest memory is, "Working with people, meeting so many good people, and making friendships that last a lifetime." While Childa feels, "the choir was very fulfilling for me, using the joy of music to comfort people and bring peace to people was very rewarding." Both recognize the difficulties that can accompany their active roles. Childa shared, "working with people can be rewarding but when differences occur it can be very challenging and frustrating, but with hard work and communication working through these differences can become rewarding for the greater good." Joe felt the weight of responsibility, "while working with the Union, the strikes were very hard, making decisions on the negotiating team which affect more than 3600 workers."

Despite difficulties, they agree that it can be very satisfying when a project comes out right, or you helped people and your community. Both Childa and Joe were able to overcome the challenges they experienced in

their early years. Childa moved often due to the nature of her dad's work; she attended 22 schools. Once, she attended four in one year! Tragically, Joe's mom died at his birth on V.E. Day. He was raised by his maternal grandparents, loved by aunts, uncles and his
