It works like this: you let Homebound know what kind of books you prefer and an assortment of those books are chosen for you once a month. They are delivered to you by volunteers, who also return your finished books back to the library. This is a great way to let those of you, who, for whatever reason, can't get out, to still have access to new reading material. Homebound can be a permanent or temporary solution depending on your needs.

# The next provincial election is Thursday, June 2, 2022

Are you registered to vote?

Have you moved since the 2018 election?

Elections Ontario has a very convenient online tool to help you make sure that you are registered to vote, it's called **e-Registration**.

The **e-Registration** tool can be used to update your address if you have moved since 2018 and can provide you with accurate details on where to vote during advanced polls or on Election Day. It can also be used to remove a deceased person from the register.

If you have turned 18 since the last election or will be a first time voter this June, you can use the **e-Registration** tool to make sure you are registered to vote. To make a change to your information or to register, you will need identification that shows your name and address. You can access the **e-Registration** at:
