To be eligible to receive this grant your small business must have:


- been required to close or to significantly restrict services because of the shutdown.

- 3) experienced a minimum of 20 percent revenue decline comparing, April 2020 to April 2019 revenues. If your business was established after April 2019 and you meet the criteria listed above, your business is still eligible to receive this grant.




