Our committee has been in place since the inception of our Parish.

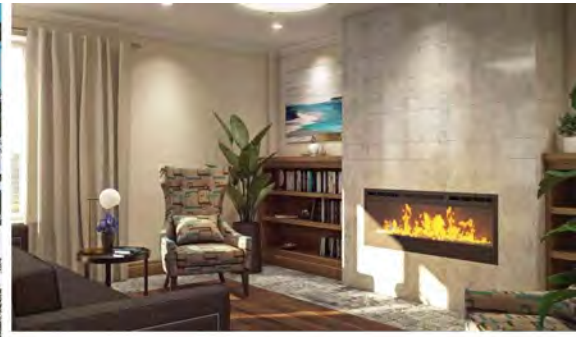
It has seen many dedicated groups of volunteers over the years.

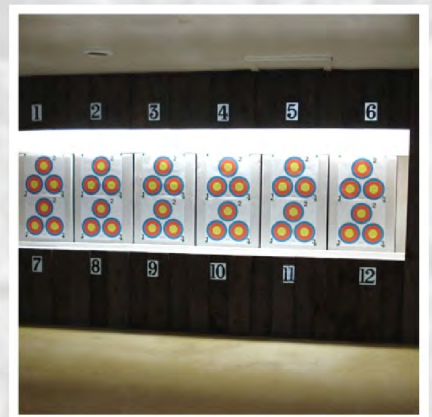

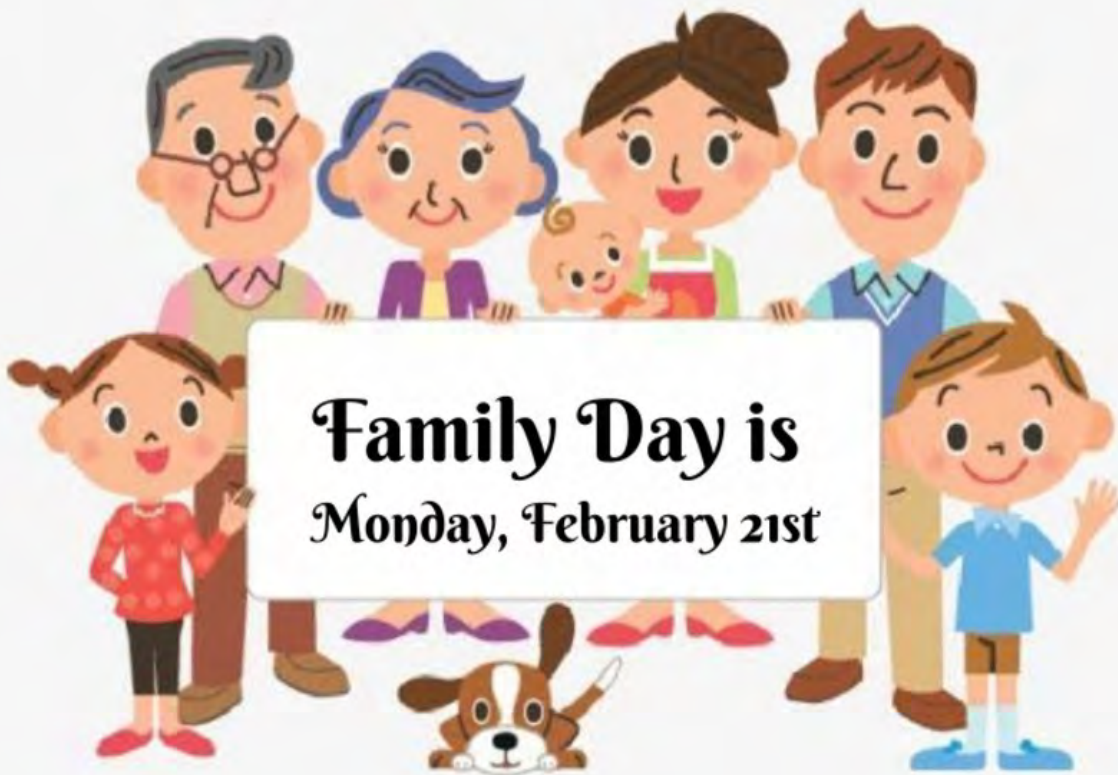
