COMMUNITY TIPS WITH GUY

MOSQUITOS in your house?

Having way too many mosquitos in the house during the overnight hours? No holes in your screens? All doors sealed?

You may want to put a light, breathable filter/screen over the intakes!

Using a thin air filter or, ideally, no-see-um screen is the best way to keep out the pests at night. Keep in mind it has to be thin enough to let your air flow freely and you don't want your a/c system working harder!
