The Ontario Tourism and Travel Small Business Support Grant was recently introduced to help small tourism and travel businesses. Just to name a few, if you are an outfitter, own a hotel, a motel, a resort or a bed and breakfast you may want to apply.

To be eligible to receive this grant your small business must have:

- 1) not received the Ontario Small Business Support Grant
- 2) fewer than 100 employees.
- 3) a revenue decline of at least 20% if the business began operating or was acquired before July 2, 2019.
