Christmas Hamper Committee Report for 2020

Happy New Year!

I apologize for being so late with our report. The end of 2020 and the beginning of 2021 was crazy. Our Hampers were not delivered this year. Instead, we had to make changes because of Covid 19. We had to come up with a way to still give out Christmas Hampers to those in need and still make sure that we kept everyone safe.

This year we set up registration days so that anyone who needed a hamper could come and register for one. They had to register themselves and their family. No one other than family members that lived in the same household were allowed to register for them. When they registered we set up a time for them to come and pick up their hamper. **Roger's Valu Mart** arranged for us to use a room at the Dowling Plaza for us to work from.

Instead of making up hampers we did things a little different (again because of Covid). We gave everyone a turkey (large families also received a ham), potatoes (donated by Jim Barrett), gravy and stuffing (donated by Roger's Valu Mart) and a voucher. The voucher was made out to Roger's Valu Mart so that the recipient could buy whatever else they would need to make Christmas dinner for their family.

The "hampers" were given out on December 15, 2020. Everyone registered was given a time to pick up their Hamper. We did this so there would not be any line up or congestion around the Plaza which would create a problem for the businesses located there and we could not let anyone into the room that we were working out of. Everything went very smoothly. I would like to thank everyone for following the rules that we set up to keep everyone safe.

This year we had 55 families sign up for a Christmas hamper. The total cost was \$4,220.64.

A **BIG Thank You** to all of the Local Businesses, Service Clubs and individuals who helped in any way and/or donated. This is truly an awesome community who look after their own. Thank you very much for your generosity! The Communities of Onaping Falls & Cartier are truly blessed to have such caring people living here.

I do have to send out a **BIG Thank You** to the **Knights of Columbus, Levack**. They have been delivering Christmas Hampers since this all began so many years ago. Times have changed and chances are there won't be anymore "deliveries" but we Thank You for all the years that you have served this community in this way.

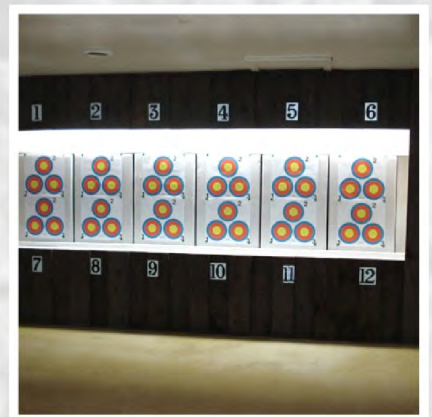

To be eligible to receive this grant your small business must have:

- 1) been required to close or to significantly restrict services because of the shutdown.
- 2) fewer than 100 employees.
- 3) experienced a minimum of 20 percent revenue decline comparing, April 2020 to April 2019 revenues. If your business was established after April 2019 and you meet the criteria listed above, your business is still eligible to receive this grant.
