Maplecrest Cemetery Revitalization

It has been a few years of struggle, trying to beautify our 90 year old cemetery on Simmons Road but it seems we have gotten somewhere this year!

In December 2013, Belanger Ready Mix approached the City of Greater Sudbury requesting a smaller buffer zone between the pit and the cemetery embankment (from 30m down to 5m) in exchange for 0.4 acres of land on the west side of the Cemetery and in 2015, after approval was received from the M.N.R. it became so. Since 2015 B.R.M. has dug to their limit and the esthetic view has been destroyed.

This proposed action, in a City document dated January 21st, 2015 would give the cemetery another 30 years of 'useful life'.

Fast forward to 2019. The City of Sudbury installed a new drainage system along the front of the cemetery on Simmons Road and new plot areas were being designed and assessed. Parts of the cemetery inner core and roadway were redesigned to accommodate burial plots and new maple trees were planted. At the same time existing trees were removed from corners. (The City stating they were old and overgrown.) I personally feel the improvements happening should be done to compliment the final resting place of many of our loved ones.



Finally in 2020, after 4 years, we saw some results. A new berm was planted last year, but an oversight in the size of trees to be planted resulted in the trees burning up and dying. The City has promised to replace the berm again. The old wrought iron fence was in need of expensive repairs and replacement which put us off the City budget docket for some time so in April 2021, and through community engagement, it was agreed that the fence be entirely replaced with a black powder coated chain link fence over the next 2 years. The water tank base has been repaired and the water tank is to be replaced. The roadway will be graded. The hydro box, that has been covered with a sheet of plywood for 2 years, is being replaced. Temporary identifying signage will be put up until our new Maplecrest sign is erected (by end of 2021). Community groups like O.F.C.A.N. and O.F.R.C. will continue to maintain and beautify alongside the City maintenance crews. Students from C.V.D.C.S. and Sudbury Secondary School have been helpful in maintenance while getting their community hours.

Thank you to everyone who offered their name and number in support of the fence. There really is 'Strength in Numbers'.

wish to save the sand for your own use!

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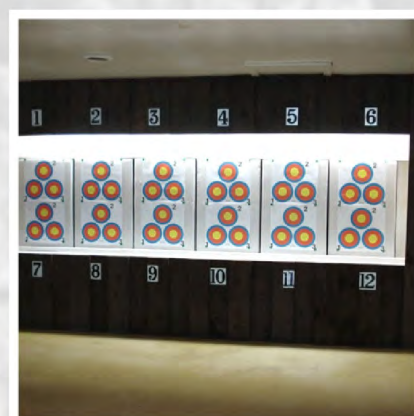
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Onaping Falls Branch 503

May is also National hamburger Month AND National Blood Pressure Month!! Go Figure!!

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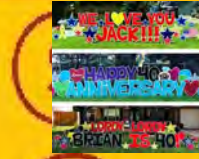
