Mining Heritage Sculpture

The Mining Heritage Sculpture can be found at Bell Park in Sudbury!

A celebration of Sudbury's mining heritage, the bronze sculpture stands 15ft high and symbolizes workers extracting mineral resources. The sculpture was unveiled in September of 2001 and had a price tag of \$750,000.

The Sudbury Mining Heritage Committee, our Federal Government's Millennium Partnership Program, along with corporate and private funding, made this monument possible. The sculpture depicts miners from the first prospectors and bare chested old timers, with their picks and axe, to modern day miners with sophisticated equipment.

The two sided monument represents the past and present of mining. Hundreds of miners descend on both sides merging into two giant hands extracting what lies beneath the Earth.

The artist, Timothy P. Schmalz is well known for his monuments which can be found worldwide. Although most of Mr. Schmalz's work carries a religious theme he has a few bronze sculptures here in Ontario. Gordon Lightfoot's 'Golden leaves', Orillia. National Women's Worker Monument, Ajax.

Canadian Veterans Memorial, Waterloo. Fallen Firefighters Monument, Kitchener. A 'Gordie Howe Alzheimers Monument' is yet to be unveiled in Calgary.

If you have not yet visited the Miners Monument at Bell Park be sure to put it on your bucket list!
