A solid 3' x 5' plaque banner is mounted inside at the front of the arena entrance for all to see. It was hard to put all of David's accomplishments on the board but a summary of his success is there. Photos of his Stanley Cup ring are also on the plaque. The photos were taken in Los Angeles and sent via text back to us here specifically for this application. Dave brought Lord Stanley home in 2019, after the St. Louis win against the Boston Bruins, to share with his friends and family. It was a wonderful gesture from Dave. Thank you to Dave's brother, Mark Taylor for making sure the sign found the perfect place in the arena.

There is small line of encouragement on the plaque as a reminder to all the players who enter our arena that your dreams really can come true.

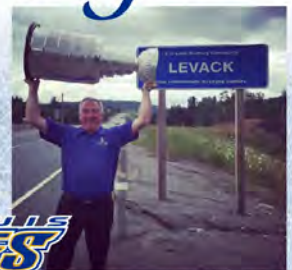

As Vice President of Hockey Operations for the 2019 Stanley Cup Champions, the St. Louis Blues, Dave brought the Stanley Cup home in July 2019 for all to see and touch! Dave played as a right wing with the Los Angeles Kings from 1977 to 1996. From 1997 to 2006 he served as General Manager of the Kings. The 2007~2010 seasons, he was with the Dallas Stars as Director of Player Personnel. Dave has been with the St. Louis Blues since 2010.

Pictured here with pride, Dave has certainly earned his Stanley Cup touch. Our community is very proud of Dave Taylor and all of his National Hockey League accomplishments.

HELPFUL TIPS FOR TOLERATING FACE COVERINGS

- (1) It is important to find a face covering that is comfortable. It should have 2 or more layers of fabric and should cover the nose, mouth and chin. It should fit snugly.
- (2) Try a 100% cotton mask if heat build up is an issue.
- (3) If kids are hesitant, explain that wearing a mask helps protect others and fights virus spread. Let them choose a fabric with a fun pattern or design.
- (4) For fogged glasses: wear a mask with a nose bridge or moldable material at the top, rest glasses over the mask or use medical tape to adhere to the nose and cheekbones.
- (5) Replace a mask once it is damp or soiled. Re-usable cloth masks should be laundered daily with fragrance-free detergent.
- (6) Wearing a face covering in public places is important but remember it is not a replacement for proper handwashing and physical distancing.

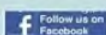

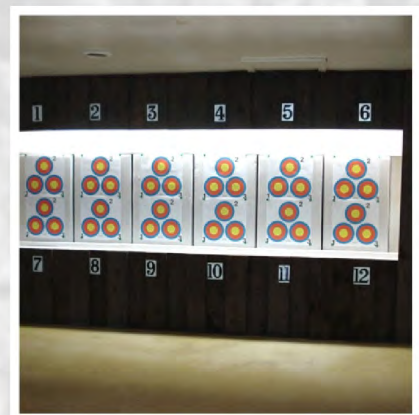
