CARING BEYOND PRECRIPTIONS

Let us first cover the facts about head lice. They are insects that can't fly.

They lay eggs on the base of the scalp hair that hatch in about 8-10 days with the entire life cycle lasting about 1 month. It is a common occurence with children but can affect adults as well and is not related to poor hygiene in any way.

Head lice can spread from close contact or sharing items like, combs, brushes, hats, towels or sleeping with an infected person. The most common sign is itching and although the live insects are hard to spot, the egg can be spotted on the hair shaft as whitish dots which are not easy to remove.

It is important to treat all family members as close contacts at the same time to prevent re-infection.

Ask your healthcare provider which product to use and it is important to follow the directions for the product chosen and repreat the treatment in 7-10 days to ensure any eggs that have hatched are gone. It is essential to remove all the eggs from the hair using fingernails, tweeezers or nit combs (very fine-tooth combs). Wetting the hair with vinegar and water will make this process much easier. Washing clothes, bedding, blankets, towels, hats and scarves in hot water and dried using the hot cycle of the dryer is also required. Soaking combs and brushes in hot soapy water for 15 minutes will make them safe to reuse. Dry clean any items that can't be washed or seal them in a plastic bag for at least 2 weeks. Rugs and furniture can be vacuumed.

Products used to treat head lice can range from insecticides such as Nix Creme Rinse, Kwellada-P Creme Rinse and R & C Shampoo to physically acting agents such a Nyda and Resultz. There have been cases of treatment failures possibly due to resistance or not using the product as directed. It is generally recommended to switch to a different type of product in this situation. Some home remedies like Vaseline and mayonnaise with Cetaphil Cleanser have shown some success while others like tea tree oil and lavender oil have not.

Confirmation of cure is important. This is done by inspecting the scalp to ensure there are no eggs present.







GOVA Zone B: Chelmsford - Levack

GOVA Zone (previously known as "TransCab") extends the reach of public transit to less populated areas of the city. If you live in a GOVA Zone service area, you can use GOVA Zone to connect with conventional transit routes at your local mobility hub. GOVA Zone services are delivered by partner taxi companies.

- There is no extra charge to take GOVA Zone: you can pay with cash or use GOVA ride cards and passes.
- · Some restrictions apply to this service.

HOW TO TAKE GOVA ZONE

TO TAKE GOVA ZONE FROM YOUR HOME OR STARTING POINT:

- Use the GOVA Zone maps to determine whether you are in a GOVA Zone service area.
- Use the schedules to determine when conventional buses connect with the service. Call the GOVA Zone service provider at least 90 minutes before your connecting bus is due to arrive at your Local Mobility Hub. When you call, you will be asked to provide your name and location for pickup.

TO TAKE GOVA ZONE BACK TO YOUR HOME OR DESTINATION:

- Ask the operator on your connecting conventional transit bus for a GOVA Zone transfer.
- At the connecting Local Mobility Hub, give the transfer and the address of your destination to the GOVA Zone service provider.
