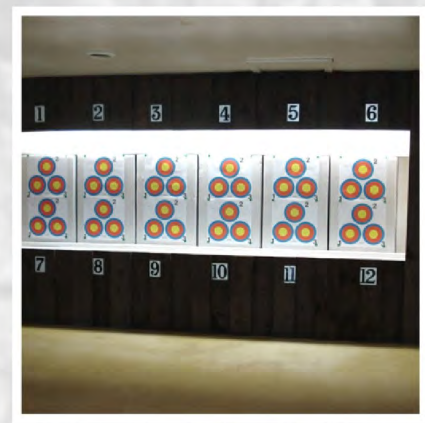

Community Action Network

Community Action Networks (CANs) bring people together to build Healthy Communities. Healthy Communities are strong and vibrant. They emerge from collaboration efforts of citizens who care about where they live and want to make their neighbourhoods the best they can possibly be.

(This statement was taken from the Greater Sudbury website regarding their CAN initiative.)

Your Onaping Falls CAN began in 1992 and has been a strong force within our 3 townships. As of August 2022 we have new CAN's working on building within our communities. In the next few months you will see the starts of a Levack Community Action Network (Levack C.A.N.) and a Dowling Community Action Network (DOWCAN). What does this mean for our communities? It means we have more support systems in place covering each of our spread out communities. With the support of the City of Greater Sudbury and it's CAN support liaison these new CAN's can build within their close know community. Stay tuned for Facebook announcements and be sure to attend their meetings if you would like to participate. But for now, join us on the Onaping Falls C.A.N. and see what we can do!

Here is a list of what your OFCAN has done for our communities since September 2018.

Fall 2019 - Participated in Halloween Night at the Dowling Leisure Centre hosted by the Lions Club.

Summer 2020 - Purchase/ Built/ Secured picnic tables at the OCC Splash Pad
December 2020 - Purchased Holiday banners and participated in the Santa Claus Parade hosted by the Northwest Fudge factory.

February 2021 - Brought community "We are in this together" banners in support of the Covid 19 pandemic battle.

September 2021 - partnered with the OFRC and City of Greater Sudbury (CGS) to upgrade the entrance at the OCC with a new cement entrance and a Handi Cap Accessible (AODA) aben. (Funding received from the New Horizons for Seniors Fund)

September 2021 - partnered with the OFRC and CGS libraries to bring and Outdoor Movie Night to the OCC.
October 2021 - partnered with the New2U Thrift Store in the OCC and hosted a Giant Yard Sale
October 2021 - participated in Junk in the Trunk Halloween downtown Levack organized by the Northwest Fudge Factory.

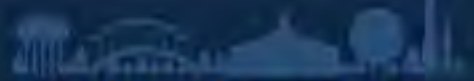

Did You KNOW?

Have you ever wondered where the name 'Onaping Falls' came from?

Prior to the early 1970's, Levack and Onaping were mining 'company towns'. Levack being an Inco town and Onaping being a Falconbridge town with no direct municipal government. Dowling was part of 'Dowling Township' an incorporated municipality.

In 1973 the three towns became part of a Regional Government.

A contest was held to 'name the new township'.

Mary Carol McLellan of Levack submitted 'Mountainvale', Dowling Town Council submitted 'Dowling' and Ted Cunningham of Onaping Submitted 'Onaping Falls'.

Onaping Falls was chosen and Mr. Cunningham received \$25 for selected name.

Chatting with Mr. Cunningham's daughter, Martha Cunningham Closs (who is the Branch Maven at the Library at the Onaping Community Centre) her memory of the name creation came from a car trip.

As they were driving around High Falls 11 year old Martha suggested the town name be 'High Falls'. Mr. C said we already have a 'High Falls' and said "it should be 'Onaping Falls' " and submitted the name.

Martha also says she made a request for \$12.50 from the win and she cannot remember whether or not she got it :)

Onaping Falls existed from 1973 to 2000. It was dissolved and amalgamated into the City of Greater Sudbury and referred to as Ward 3.

Before amalgamation we had 4 Mayors, during our 27 years.

Jim "I.J." Coady, Bob Parker, Shirley Mirka and Jean Guy "Chummy" Quesnel.

All who represented 'Onaping Falls' with pride and dignity.
