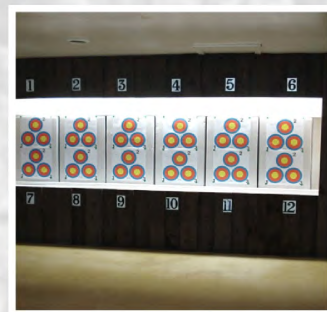
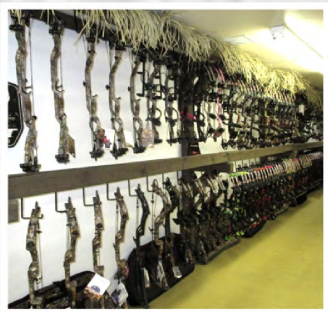

WARD 3 TOWNHALL MEETING

The WARD 3 Town hall meeting was held on March 8th at the Onaping Community Centre. Following through on a campaign promise to listen to the constituents of each Ward, Mayor Lefebvre has been holding meetings in the Wards of Greater Sudbury, co hosting with each Wards prospective Councillor. Ward 3 Councillor Gerry Montpellier was present as were a few of the Greater Sudbury staff members.

Here are a few positive things that came out of the meeting.

At the start of the meeting the Mayor announced that the City has committed to repair the Onaping Community Centre. He said the Community Centre will be receiving a new roof, new windows and a paint job and there will be more to come!

That seemed to be the only definite answer that came out of the meeting. Other items that were discussed. The meeting can be viewed at <https://fb.watch/jchTd-Rt9R/>

Snowplowing and sidewalk plowing were brought up and the Mayor advised that he and Councillor Montpellier will bring a motion to City Council in April to look at the current service levels and see where improvements can be made.

The report will be ready in the 3rd quarter of 2023..

Covid vaccinations shots became a topic and the Mayor averted to the Sudbury & District Health Unit on that. All decisions were made following SDHU protocol.

Will our Onaping Community Pool be CLOSED? Answer: At this time the City is reviewing all the pools to see what needs to be done and the cost associated with repair and maintenance of the facility.

Why was the L.J. Coady Memorial Arena (Levack Arena) roof replacement postponed? Once again we were told that roof replacements that were scheduled are under review and decisions will come after City Staff finish their reviews.

There were not many concrete answers given. Many things are still unknown but we are on the map it seems to Mayor Lefebvre and his staff at the City of Greater Sudbury.

The Mayor attended our Onaping Falls Winter Carnival in February two out of the three days. During those days he visited our facilities and familiarized himself with our towns.

That is an important step as he has only been in office since November 15th, 2022.

Let's see where we go from here!
