

Ontario Learn and Stay Grant

We need more health care workers in Ontario.

Our region has been identified as a priority community in Ontario and students can access the new **Ontario Learn and Stay Grant.** The grant covers the cost of tuition, books, compulsory fees, necessary equipment and supplies for students enrolled in priority health care programs at participating post-secondary institutions including Collège Boréal, Cambrian College and Laurentian University in Sudbury.

Programs include select nursing, paramedic and medical laboratory technology/ medical laboratory science at the diploma, undergraduate and graduate levels.

The grant requires students to learn and work in the region where they study, which includes a six month service commitment.

With Spring on its way, watch for some seedlings and seeds in the Levack Onaping Library. We will be continuing our seed exchange soon! Watch for details!




