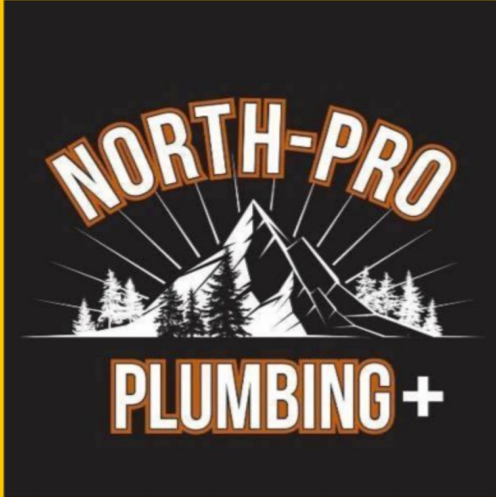

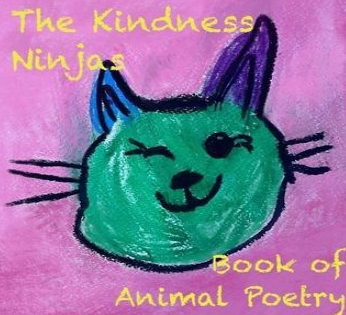

PLAQUE UNVEILING *for* DIANA YOUNG

A love for reading and a desire to make books more accessible to the community of Dowling was the driving force behind Diana Youngs efforts to bring a library close to home.

Diana was instrumental in bringing the first public library to Dowling in the 70's. She was featured in an Onaping Falls News article back in 1975 for International Women's Day and continued helping her community for another 40 plus years.



On June 22nd the Dowling Library held an unveiling event to present a beautiful plaque with an etching of Diana and a story of how she sold 150 memberships to fund the start of the library that began in Larchwood Public School. Diana is known as the Founder of Dowlings first local library. The memorial plaque is touching and heartwarming to read.

Pictured in the photo to the left is Sudbury Mayor Paul Lefebvre with Diana's daughter Cheryl. The Mayor attended the unveiling and spoke a few words in honour of Diana. 50 people attended the small ceremony in honour of their friend and neighbour.

For years Diana ran her catering business in Dowling and if there was an event on our community it was catered by Dianas Catering.

She is dearly missed by her family and the Townships in Onaping Falls. Diana passed away in August of 2022 but this beautiful plaque that will adorn the walls of the Dowling Library remind us of who she was and what she did for us. We will always be indebted to her for our library and the many hours she gave to us!

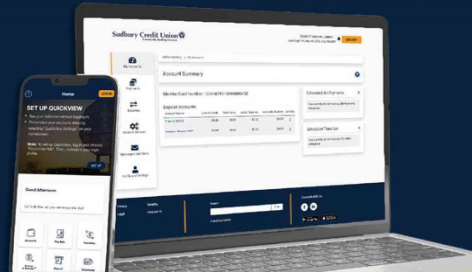

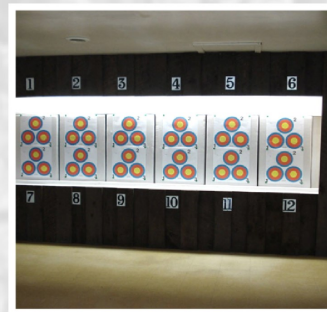
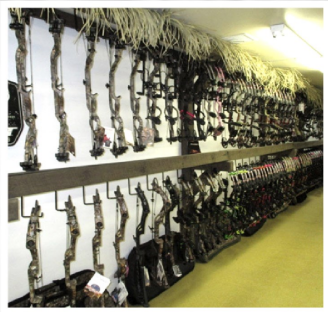

Retirement homes have an obligation to ensure the rights of residents are respected so that their homes are a place where they can live in comfort and be their authentic selves.

The **Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (RHRA)** is a not-for-profit regulator mandated by the government of Ontario to ensure the safety and well-being of retirement home residents. This includes enforcing the Residents' Bill of Rights, licensing and inspecting retirement homes and enabling informed decision-making by residents and their loved ones.

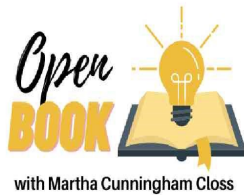

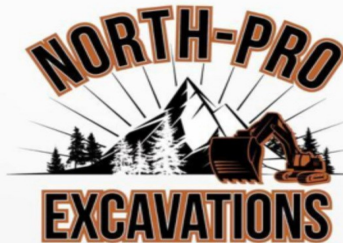

Class of 2023 Valedictorian.

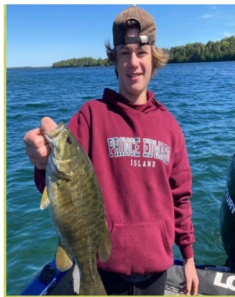
Devon's family has deep roots in Onaping Falls.
