

On Monday September 25th we hosted our 1st Cavalcade Bingo with the proceeds going to Falls Food, the Onaping Falls Food Bank.


We had a great turnout to help us kick of Cavalcade of Colours week and we were able to donate \$800 to Falls Food.





I want to share a helpful resource for any questions or concerns you have about the care you receive from your family physician or any doctor.

In our province, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) licenses doctors and sets the policies that guide how they care for their patients.

Did you know that having to wait for months to see your doctor, only getting to talk about one issue per appointment or being delisted for visiting a different walk-in clinic than the one you were told to use, are all practices that are against the CPSO's guidelines?

If you have questions about your doctor's care, I encourage you to call the CPSO and talk to them about it. They may be reached at:
