Approximately 300 students and adults visited the Open House.

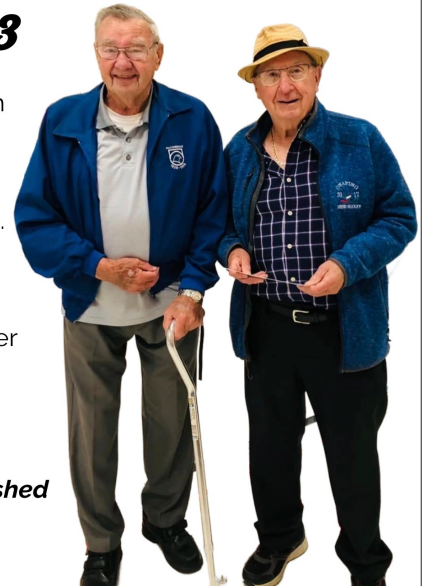
Students from St. Etienne, Larchwood and Levack all had the chance to visit booth and fill out passports. Once they learned about each booth they were given a stamp on their passport.

Did you know that having to wait for months to see your doctor, only getting to talk about one issue per appointment or being delisted for visiting a different walk-in clinic than the one you were told to use, are all practices that are against the CPSO's guidelines?
