So we're just trying to carry on a heritage and a legacy for my father. And I just want to say one thing. It's fine to say the Day Group is receiving this award but I want to tell you, there are many, many employees that made all this for us! We wouldn't be doing it without them!'

Bart was born and raised in Dowling and raised his family in our community. Now his children are raising their families close by. The Day family has been a huge supporter to our community for all of our events.


SPLASH PAD IS OPEN AT THE ONAPING COMMUNITY CENTRE





The Ontario Learn and Stay Grant for the 2024-2025 academic year is available once again.

The grant is for students in regions of Ontario, such as Nickel Belt, that are short health care workers, studying in priority programs at the diploma, undergraduate, masters and postgraduate levels.

Programs include:

- Practical Nursing
- Paramedic
- Medical Laboratory Technology / Science
- Bachelor Honours / Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Master of Science in Nursing / Nurse Practitioner MSc Nursing

Many of the eligible programs are offered at Cambrian College, Laurentian University, College Boréal, CTS Canadian Career College and Northern College.

The Ontario Learn and Stay Grant requires that the graduate commit to working in the region where they studied for a minimum of six months for every year of study funded by the grant.

(You may notice a slight accent when he speaks)


Worked in T.O. for a bit and then moved up here
