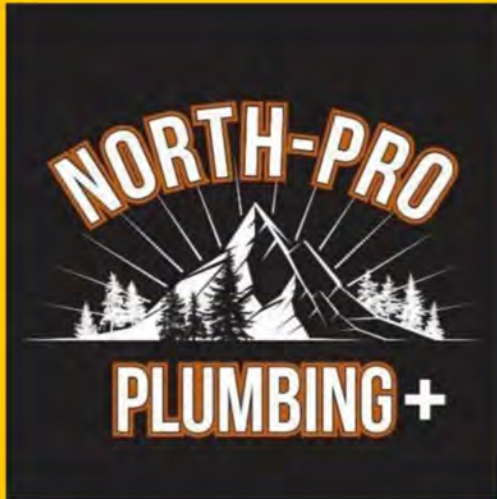

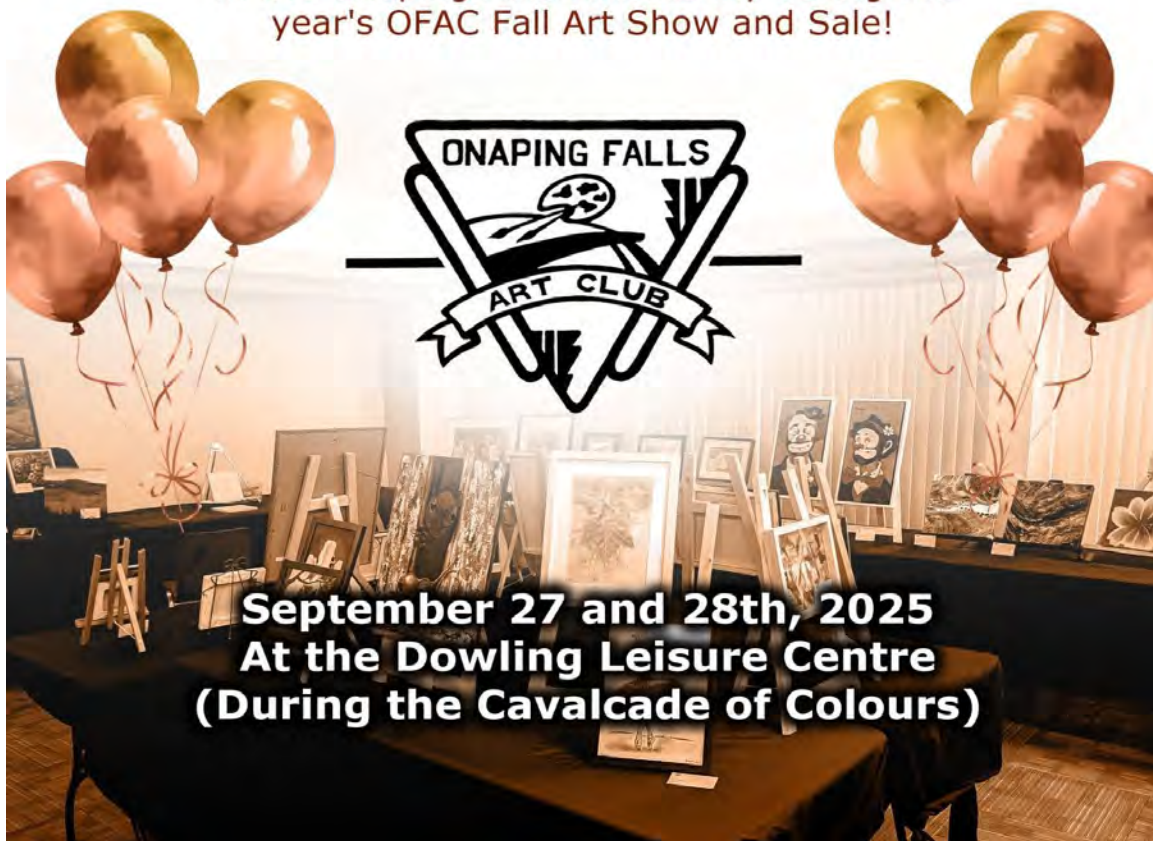

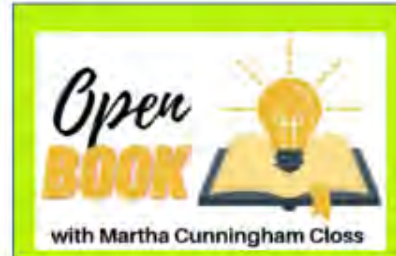

Whether you visit often or come looking for the first time, the library belongs to you! I'd be happy to show you around!

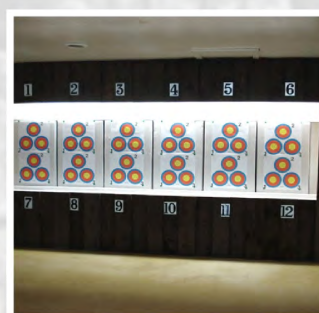
