



The month of March is **Fraud Prevention Month**. No one deserves to be a victim of fraud. A good way to prevent fraud is to learn about common scams and to learn how to identify them.

The following are signs to look out for when dealing with scams. You might be a victim of fraud, if you are:

- feeling pressured to make a quick decision
- being requested to keep matters confidential
- being asked to provide money in unusual formats such as gift cards, bit coin and prepaid credit cards
- receiving an email from an unknown sender with a link or an attachment


