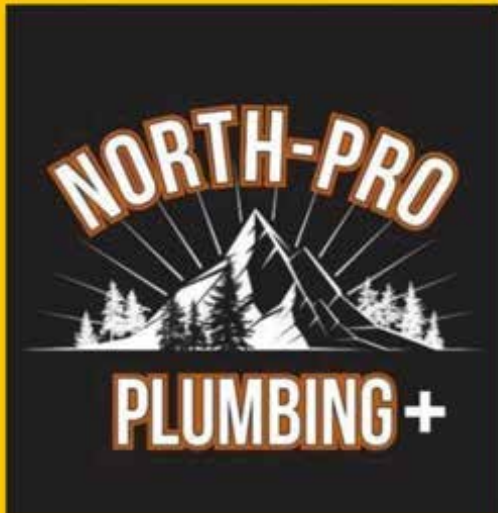

The Wellness RX

Tick season is upon us once again
and we are here to help keep you
and your family (and your pets) safe!

Here are some tips on preventing tick bites:

- Avoid walking through grassy areas; instead remain in the middle of the pathways!
- Ensure pants and shirts are tight at ankles and wrists or tucked into socks or gloves.
- Wear light coloured, long sleeved shirts and pants to more easily see ticks.
- Use repellent that indicates on the label that it repels ticks.
- Check yourself, family members and pets for ticks before returning indoors. If you find one, remove it immediately.
- Shower or bathe within 2 hours of being outdoors; this can help dislodge unattached ticks.
- Do not apply heat or poison of any kind to ticks; this does not work and may be harmful
- In the event of a tick bite, call the pharmacy as you may benefit from post-exposure prophylactic treatment.
