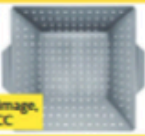

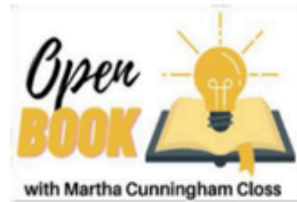

#### Sun Safety

*Now that summer is 'finally' upon us it is important to prevent skin damage such as sunburn, wrinkles and skin cancer. Here are some tips to help keep you and your family safe from the sun:*

- Stay out of the sun between 10am & 4pm when the sun's rays are the strongest.
- For adults and children 6 months of age and older wear a broad spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or more.
- To get the most out of your sunscreen apply a thick amount to all skin that is exposed to the sun 20 minutes before you go outside and reapply it 15-30 minutes later for the best protection.
- Reapply after swimming, towelling off or sweating. Also reapply after you are in the sun for a prolonged period of time.
- Apply sunscreen even on cloudy days.
- If using a spray on sunscreen spray generously and make sure you don't breathe it in.
- Remember: tanning increases the risk of sun damage and does not offer protection from further sun damage.

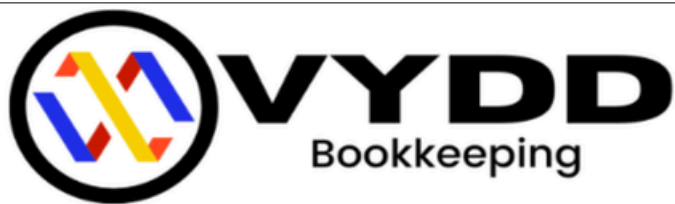

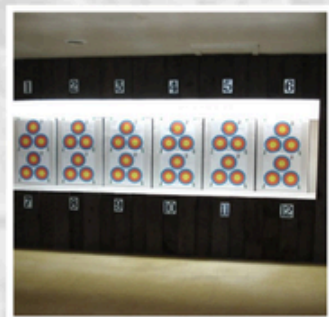
