Listening and learning. We are so fortunate to have Hans available to us.

His wonderful daughter Teresa always accompanies her father to many locations.

When you visit the A.Y. Jackson Lookout there is a giant Ore Core on display by the building. Some time ago there was an incident at the Levack Mine. A part of the mine was about to collapse and they needed to back fill the area to prevent disaster. It was Hans' idea to get a large diamond drill from the USA and drill down to the 500 foot level and then backfill it. The deed was done and the impending collapse prevented. The 3' piece displayed is from the core removed.

Hans began his mining career at 20 years old.

The man is a wealth of knowledge and joy to speak with and listen to!
His love for mining is true. He has done an incredible job archiving Sudbury mining.
A true Northern Ontario Mining Legend!

sweating or urinating, if you vomit or if you
start to feel confused.

Prevention tips: avoid strenuous outdoor
activities when the sun is the hottest; stay in the
shade if possible; take several breaks during
outdoor activities; drink plenty of fluids before,
during and after outdoor activities.
Limit coffee, tea, cola and alcohol as they can
cause dehydration.

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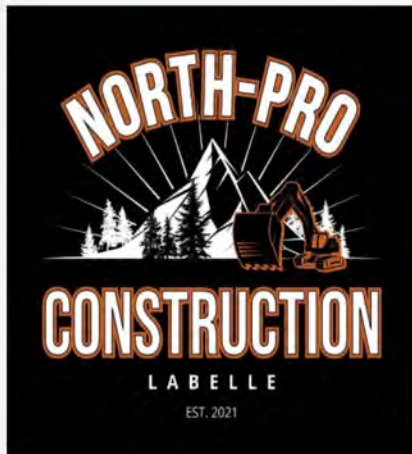
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It's August! Come see us Monday through Thursday in the summer during the hot weather! We are air-conditioned! It's your library. Come hang out!

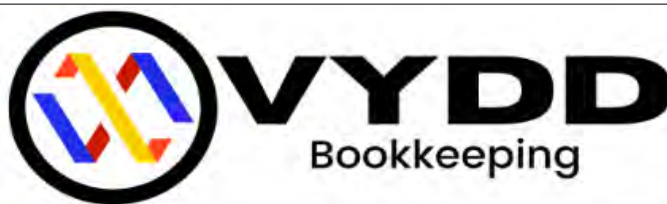
